1. Class schedule, course readings, and other resources are posted at modjeskaschool.com. Students will receive an email each week with the password-protected study guide and a link to join on Zoom.
2. We record all of the classes and post them at modjeskaschool.com after each session. Students who miss a class are expected to view the recording on their own.
